Notice is hereby given that Sub-Bid proposals for Bay Area Hospital - Rapid Medical Evaluation project will be received by Harmon Construction Company, 61393 Highway 101, Coos Bay, Oregon, 97420, until bid closing time of **2:00 P.M. Pacific Time, Tuesday, February 21, 2017**. Sub-Bids received after the deadline will not be considered. There will be no public opening of Sub-Bids. Sub-Bids will be opened in the presence of the Owner or Owner's Representative.

A non-mandatory walkthrough will be held on **Wednesday, February 15, 2017 11a.m.** at the main third floor lobby.

The contractor reserves the right to reject any and all Sub-Bids, and to waive any technicalities or informalities in connection therewith. No Sub-Bidder may withdraw his Sub-Bid after the hour set for the opening thereof until the lapse of thirty (30) days from the bid opening.
