NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Sealed bids for the **Intermediate Transmission Main, CIP No. 430000** will be received at the front desk in the main lobby of Gresham City Hall, 1333 N.W. Eastman Parkway, Gresham, Oregon 97030, addressed to **Jason Branstetter, P.E.**, until **Thursday, March 2ND, 2017, at 2:00PM** local time. Late bids will be retained unopened. The bids will be publicly opened immediately thereafter in **Conference Room 2A**. The Engineer's Estimate for this project is \$805,000.

The character of the work is construction of a 12-inch diameter waterline and associated appurtenances. The major quantities of work involved in this project are:

This project is for public work and is subject to ORS 279C.800 to 279C.870, the Oregon Prevailing Wage Law.

All bids must be submitted on the forms furnished by the City of Gresham, mailed or delivered in a sealed envelope plainly marked "SEALED BID for INTERMEDIATE TRANSMISSION MAIN" and bearing the name and address of the bidder. The bid must be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond in an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the total bid.
